Notice of Rotary Adopt A School Awards and Booklet (2013-14)

As previous years, **RAAS** (**Rotary Adopt A School**) **Awards** honour the contributions of Rotarians and teachers as well as recognising students with information extracted below.

1. RAAS Awards (Deadline for enrollment is Friday, 6 June, 2014)

A. RAAS Award

- a. An Award to the **Rotary Club** in which Rotarians have participated the most of RAAS programs or activities organised by RAAS Committee.
- b. An Award to the **Rotarian** who has participated the most of RAAS programs or activities organised by RAAS Committee.
- c. An Award to the **school** that has participated the most of RAAS programs or activities organised by RAAS Committee.
- d. An Award to the **teacher** who has led the most of students to participate RAAS programs or activities organised by RAAS Committee.
- e. An Award to the **student** who has participated the most of RAAS programs or activities organised by RAAS Committee.

B. Best Improvement Award for 4 students

RAAS will award 4 students nominated by the principals of our RAAS Partnering Schools to be the Best Improvement students of this school year.

The Prize of the Best Improvement Award is a free helicopter ride around Hong Kong Island offered by Ms Lily Fenn, Past President of Rotary Club of Happy Valley. As informed by Ms Fenn, the free helicopter flight is tentatively scheduled in November this year and subject to her discretion as Ms Fenn's new helicopter will be ready by then.

2. RAAS Booklet

Rotary Adopt A School Committee is going to work out a booklet for RAAS for the year of 2013-2014 in order to keep all the great work that you have already done so far and share them with others.
