7. 2015 Eco-Challenge Competition

This is a joint project among the District Preserve Planet Earth Committee (PPE) and United Nations Environmental Program (UNEP-DHI). It aims to raise the awareness of the importance of managing limited water resources in the face of rapid economic development worldwide. Target audience is young people between 11-17 years old.

The Eco-Challenge is an international competition and basically a video-game competition to build a virtual city which is the most efficient in handling water resources. The more efficient the city is in handling water resources, the higher points the competitors will score. Obviously the competitor with the highest score will win the competition. There are many techniques to build a water-efficient city and there will be training session to educate participants on such techniques or technology. The top 6 teams from Hong Kong will go to Korea in April to compete against the winning teams of 12 other countries.
