In the afternoon of the same day, a delegation of 19 Rotarians and one spouse went to Beijing for 4 days, to visit the Ministry of Health, Ministry of Civil Affairs, Ministry of All-China Youth Federation and the United Front Work Department of the CPC Central Committee. There

was a special mission for the delegation this year, which was the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between Rotary International District 3450 and the Ministry of Health of China, aiming to immunize Hepatitis B for the newly born babies in certain parts of China. The ten-year project targeted to immunize approximately one hundred thousand babies each year. It will be a pilot project for the first three years. Should it be successful, the project will be continued for the rest of the period.

The signing ceremony took place at 2:30pm on 15 April 2002, Monday, at the Ministry of Health, witnessed by PDG Moses Cheng, Chairman of China Committee of D-3450 and Mr. Zang Wen Kang, Minister of Health, China. District 3450 was represented by DG Johnson Chu, DGE Gloria Chan and DGN Jones Wong, while Liu Peilong, Director General, representing the Ministry of Health. All District 3450

The Interactors have been doing excellent, arranging successful functions including a Bazaar held in last August. Under the leadership of District Interact Committee Chairman, PP Vincent Ng, the Interactors have no doubt demonstrated MANKIND IS OUR BUSINESS.

From 1 July 2001, District 3450 comprises 49 clubs, 42 in Hong Kong, 6 in Macau and 1 in Mongolia. On Tuesday morning, ten delegates went to the City of Handan in Hebei Province, a possible site of the Hepatitis B project, to visit their health facilities, a clinic and several families in a village. People are very poor, without tap water supply. There are only wells dug for storing water caught during the rain season. But the water is not suitable for drinking. Residents have to go a long way to get drinking water. Therefore, they really need help to improve their health conditions. Nevertheless, we were warmly greeted by Mayor Zhang Li, Vice Mayor Xin Bao Shan and other health officers of the city. Our car was led by a police car, both from Beijing to Handan and back, for the purpose of clearing any traffic obstacles to ensure our traveling schedule is smooth and

The District Assembly was held on Saturday, 20 April 2002. It was well attended and organized. Immediately after the Assembly, which ended at about 4:30 pm, I went to Macau to attend an annual fund-raising ball of the Rotary Club of Hou Kuong. I returned at midnight for a big function on the following day - Tree Planting Day.

Tree Planting is an annual district event held each year. The venue for this year is changed to Tai Mo Shan, next to the Rotary Park. The event is always well supported by Rotarians who bring along their spouses and children aged as young as 5 years old. It was a sunny day with approximately 700 participants this year, including 93 year-old Charter President of Rotary Club of Kowloon East, Dr. Ng Tor Tai, who walked up to the tree planting spot without any escort. A group of photographers from Television Broadcasts Limited was there to take some videorecording and made interviews with several Rotarians for release at the Rotary Show, which is aimed to enhance Rotary image to the public. Tree Planting not only contributes to environment protection but also attracts the most participants among all district events because it is a family day for Rotarians. This event should be continued in the years to come.

Immediately after the great event, DGN Jones Wong and I have to go to Macau to attend another meaningful event there. It was the New Generations Conference, organized by the Rotaract and Interact Clubs in Macau with PP Rocky Chung as the organizing committee chairman. Secretaries from four Government Departments were panelists. Each of them gave a detailed introduction of the work and

responsibility of his or her department, followed by questions and answers period, during which many questions were put forward by students. The master of ceremony had an outstanding performance and managed her time very well. I learned afterwards that she is a Rotaractor as well as a Group Study Exchange team member of last year. It is indeed encouraging to see such a talented Rotaractor, hoping she will one day become a Rotarian serving in the district level!

The R.I. Convention 2002 held in Barcelona will soon arrive. Rotarians wishing to attend should register and make reservations for flight and hotel. This convention will give us the opportunity to show that Rotary is, and will continue to be, a leader in promoting international understanding. The list of speakers include Nobel Peace Prize Winner Laureate Mikhail Gorbachev and the world-famous entertainer Jerry Lewis, who will also headline the closing night show. R.I. President Richard King hopes to see at least 20 Rotarians from District 3450 in Barcelona. Fellow Rotarians, please do your best to support the Barcelona Convention to show "MANKIND IS OUR BUSINESS."


# 候任區總監感言

# The Birth Of The First Mongolian Speaking Rotary Club

Wednesday 27.02.2002

"Dear President Oyungerel: Congratulations! The Rotary Club of Khuree, Mongolia, is now officially admitted to membership of Rotary International on 27 February, 2002, and is becoming the 50th club of District 3450," e-mail sent by District Governor Johnson Chu on 5 March, 2002, at 12:30.

On 24 March, 2002, during the Farewell Luncheon of 2002 Asian Presidential Conference, RI President Richard D. King presented the club charter to Charter President J. Oyungerel, in front of over 800 Rotarians from some 23 countries across Asia and other continents. Also on the stage were RI Vice President Gary Huang, Chairman of the Conference; District Governor Johnson Chu; President L. Gombo of Rotary Club of Ulaanbaatar (sponsoring club); President Elect N. Batbold, Director O. Jandavsuren of Rotary Club of Khuree. The ceremony was also witnessed by 12 Rotary leaders from Hong Kong including Governor Elect Gloria Chan and Governor Nominee Jones Wong, and from Mongolia 4 members of the Rotary Club of Ulaanbaatar.

The birth of The Rotary Club of Khuree was the fruit of a mini seminar held inside a gher on the green pastoral land, under the blue sky, in the countryside of Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia.

The extension idea of the second Rotary club in Mongolia may be chased back to the year when John Wan was the district governor, and the whole country of Mongolia was combined by RI to District 3450 together with Hong Kong and Macau on 1 July, 2000. The proposal was conveyed by CP Herbert K. Lau (Tolo Harbour) to the Rotary Club of Ulaanbaatar. However, after several debates amongst the members, the extension of the second new club was not approved.

The idea of forming a new club in Mongolia was then passed to the next Year of 2001-02 when the Global Quest of Membership Development is the major task of the Rotary movement worldwide. In consideration of the members from The Rotary Club of Ulaanbaatar might not be able to attend the District Membership

Development Seminar held in Hong Kong on 4 August, 2001, a special arrangement was granted by Past Governor Dr. Raymond Wong, District Chairman for Membership Development.

During the visit to Ulaanbaatar, C P Herbert, Membership Development Coordinator for Mongolia, conducted a mini seminar on 1 August. The meeting was held inside a gher. Ulaanbaatar members participating were President L. Gombo, President Elect N. Zaankhuu, Vice President J. Oyungerel, Treasurer B. Undarlaa, International Service Director N. Batbold, New Generations Chairman S. Bekhbat. Special guests attending were RI Vice President Gary Huang (Taipei), Governor Elect Gloria Chan (Queensway), Past President William Benter (Kowloon North), Past President Dato Dr. Tan Hian Tsin (Garden City, Singapore) and Mr. Wen Huang (Information Specialist from RI).

After a broad discussion on the importance of Rotary membership development in Mongolia, it was proposed and was unanimously agreed by all participants that a new club should be organized within this Rotary year. The new club will: (1) be sharing the territory of Ulaanbaatar; (2) be a Mongolian speaking club; (3) have a Mongolian charter president. In order to show the support to this new club, RIVP Gary proposed to set up an initial working fund for this project. He immediately contributed US\$100, followed the same by DGE Gloria, PP Bill, Dr. Tan and CP Herbert.

On 15 August, 2001, the board of Ulaanbaatar Rotary Club approved the sponsoring of a new club. The charter president designate was Mrs. J. Oyungerel (charter member and Vice President of the Club).

8 September, 2001, Mrs. J. Oyungerel and Dr. R. Oyun attended the District Rotary Foundation Seminar in Hong Kong. After the Seminar, these 2 ladies met CP Herbert for a 2-hour discussion, and received a set of 7 manuals and handbooks plus 100 copies of small booklet "This Is Rotary".

The first planning meeting was held on 22 September. The first provisional meeting was held on 13 October at Hotel Edelweiss, Ulaanbaatar. The booklets "This Is Rotary" were

distributed to 22 recruits.

The second provisional meeting attended by 23 recruits was held on 26 October at Monand Cafe'. President L. Gombo was the speaker to share his Rotary experience in Hong Kong and Kuala Lumpur.

The third provisional meeting attended by 26 recruits was held on 2 November. District Governor's Special Representative Ch. Ganbold presided the meeting, and the following were decided: (1) The Club Constitution and Bylaws; (2) The name of the club would be KHUREE (old name of the capital city before 1924); (3) Regular evening meetings to be held every Thursday at 18:30, Mona Liza Cafe', Sukhbaatar District; (4) Admission Fees would be US\$ 25 and Annual Fees would be US\$ 100.

The total number of charter members is 35 with 18 men and 17 women. There are 5 MPs (Member of Parliament) and 2 central government officials. The officers of the Club are:

# 第一個蒙古語扶輪社的誕生

27.02.2002 星期三

"教蓉姬社長:恭喜你!2002年2月27日國際扶輪 正式核准蒙古國庫倫扶輪社(The Rotary Club of Khuree)成為會員,同時亦正式成為第3450地區的第 50個會員社。"朱梓焜總監在2002年3月5日下午12時 30分發出了賀電。

3月24日,在2002國際扶輪社長亞洲會議的惜別午宴上,國際扶輪社長金恩向創立社長敖蓉姬(J. Oyungerel)頒授了證書,禮台上還有國際扶輪副社長黃其光(會議主席)、3450地區總監朱梓焜、烏蘭巴托社社長甘博(L. Gombo)、庫倫社候任社長白寶(N. Batbold)、理事珍岱夫索倫(O. Jandavsuren)。在場見證者尚有來自23個國家和五大洲的八百多位社員,12位從香港赴會的扶輪領袖(包括總監當選人陳麥幗斌和總監提名人王仲熹),以及四位蒙古國烏蘭巴托社的社員。

庫倫扶輪社的誕生是一次小型研討會的成果。 該次研討會是在藍天白雲下,鳥蘭巴托市郊的綠油 油草原上的一個蒙古包內舉行。

在蒙古擴展第二個扶輪社的雛議,可以追溯回 温頌安擔任地區總監的那一年。當年,2000年7月1日 國際扶輪決定把蒙古國的整個領域,與香港和澳門 合併,撥歸第3450地區管理。擴展新社的提案,由劉 敬恆創社社長負責向烏蘭巴托社轉達。可惜,經過了 多次辯論之後,擴展新社的提案依然未能一致通過。

於是,擴展新社的提案順延至下一個年度,即 2001-02年度。這一年,國際扶輪以全球性擴展社員為 主要工作,發動了"全球微召大行動"(Global Quest)。為 了配合形勢,2001年8月4日,香港準備舉行"地區社 員擴展研討會"。蒙古方面的社員表示到香港出席, 在客觀條件上會有困難。有鑑於此,在得到地區社員 擴展主任委員黃志偉前總監的允許下,給予特殊安 排。 2002年7月杪,劉敬恆(吐露港社)訪問了烏蘭巴托·8月1日,就在市郊的一座蒙古包內,召開了一個小型的社員擴展研討會。到會者有烏蘭巴托社的社長甘博(L. Gombo)、候任社長山呼(N. Zaankhuu)、副社長敖蓉姫(J. Oyungerel)、司庫殷黛娜(B. Undarlaa)、國際服務理事白寶(N. Batbold)、新世代主委碧迦伯(S. Bekhbat)。特別嘉賓尚有國際扶輪副社長黃其光(台北社)、我區總監當選人陳麥幗斌(君城社)、前社長William Benter (九龍北區社)、前社長拿督陳賢進博士(新加坡獅城社)以及黃文廣先生(國際扶輪傳訊部幹事)。

經過一輪廣泛討論在蒙古擴展社員的重要性之後,"擴展新社"的動議再次提出。最後,與會者都一致贊成蒙古應該再擴展一個新的扶輪社,並定出三個指引:(1)這個新社將與烏蘭巴托社共享同一領域;(2)蒙古語是主要語言;(3)創立社長必須是蒙古國民。隨後,國際扶輪副社長黃其光積極鼓勵,並發動所有出席的海外扶輪領袖,每位捐獻一百美元,作為新社的啟動經費。

2001年8月15日,烏蘭巴托社舉行了理事會,通 過了擴展和輔導新社的提案,並同時推舉該社的創 社社員、副社長教蓉姬女士,為新社的創立社長。

2001年9月8日,教蓉姬女士聯同教融博士(Dr. R. Oyun)到香港出席地區扶輪基金研討會。會後,劉敬恆與兩位會談了兩小時,並送贈7種扶輪手冊和書刊,以及100份"這就是扶輪"(This Is Rotary)小冊子。

第一次組織會議在9月22日舉行。第一次臨時 社例會在10月13日假座烏蘭巴托市的小白花酒店 (Hotel Edelweiss)舉行,並派送了"這就是扶輪"小冊子 予22位新員。

第二次臨時社例會在10月26日假座慕蘭餐館 (Monand Cafe)舉行,出席者有23位新員。當晚,甘博社 長向會眾分享了他到香港和吉隆坡扶輪會議取經 的經歷。

第三次臨時社例會在11月2日舉行,共有26位 新員。總監特別代表干實(Ch. Ganbold)主持了會議。 會議決定了幾件事:(1)社的章程和細則;(2)社名定 名為"庫倫"(首都烏蘭巴托在1924年以前的名稱); (3)例會定於逢星期四晚上6時30分假座索克巴托區 的蒙羅麗莎餐館(Mona Liza Cafe)舉行;(4)徵收每位社 員的入社費25美元,年費100美元。

該社現有35位創社社員,18男17女。其中5位是 國會議員,2位是國家政府官員。

該社的職員如下:

### First Rotary Club Chartered in United Areb Emirates 阿拉伯聯合酋長國的 第一個扶輪社正式授證

Rotary International President Richard D. King presented the charter of the Rotary Club of Dubai on 3 March. As the first Rotary club in the United Arab Emirates, the Dubai club represents a historic step in membership growth and extension in the Muslim and Arab world.

"I am flattered to charter the first Rotary club in the UAE," said President King, according to the Gulf News newspaper. "Sheikh Ahmed bin Saeed Al Maktoum, president of Dubai Civil Aviation and chairman of Emirates [local airline], will be the charter president of the club." The RI president was hopeful that the 25 members of the new club would join other Rotarians in the region in promoting a positive image of Rotary as a non-political and non-partisan service organization.

The charter of the Rotary Club of Dubai brings the number of clubs in District 2450 to 103, with nearly 4,000 members across seven Middle Eastern countries.

### A New Model Rotary Club is Chartered in Paris 嶄新型式的扶輸社在巴黎正式授證

With the charter of the Rotary Club of Paris Agora, the French capital is now in the forefront of a process aimed at developing new models for clubs to meet the challenges of the 21st century.

The club is one of more than 190 New Model Rotary Clubs participating in an RI board-approved pilot project authorized by the 2001 Council on Legislation to develop clubs that will be more attractive to younger professional and business leaders, and increase the effectiveness of clubs and future potential for membership growth and extension.

Some 150 Rotarians and Rotaractors attended the 16 February charter ceremony. Senior Rotary leaders present included District Governors Gerard Morel (D-1660) and Jean-Louis Devoret (D-1750), Past RI Director Jacques Berthet, who also is chairman of the RI European Affairs Committee, and Past District Governor Jacques Paaleret, National Coordinator for New Model Rotary Clubs. Visiting Rotarians from Senegal and the United States joined their French colleagues at the event.

"As the oldest club in France, it is a great opportunity for the Rotary club of Paris to sponsor this new club which will bring new ideas and new projects in the world of Rotary," said Past District Governor Bernard Dervaux, who first proposed the idea of a New Model Rotary club in Paris.

Drawn from various professions and businesses, the 25 members of the Rotary Club of Paris Agora include nine women, five former Rotaractors, and an ex-Lions club member. The club is different from a traditional Rotary club in many respects. Because attendance is calculated based on participation in projects, as well as committee and board meetings, members meet only twice in a month. A member can make up by attending a Rotary or Rotaract club meeting or a district or RI event. With a younger average age (33), the Agora club Rotarians pay only regular dues (no admission fee) that are lower than those in other Paris Rotary clubs. Also, the club aims to replace regular club committees with smaller project teams, and will hold some board meetings online.
